At convention in Lexington, KY a new national LWML mission goal of \$2,150,000 for the 2021-2023 biennium was passed. Let's all do our part to help meet the goal and fund the grants.

**National Grant #1** in the amount of \$81,680 will fund one year of deaconess ministry at the Dakota Boy and Girls Ranch. At the ranch children, ages 10-18 and their families find new beginnings through Christ-centered and mercy-focused care.



**District Grant #16:** \$10,000 for Hospice of Yuma. As Yuma's only nonprofit hospice, the "I Make A Difference" project allows funds to stay local and help terminally ill patients with no insurance or ability to pay for care.
